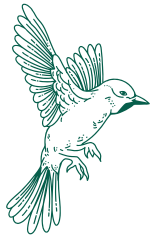

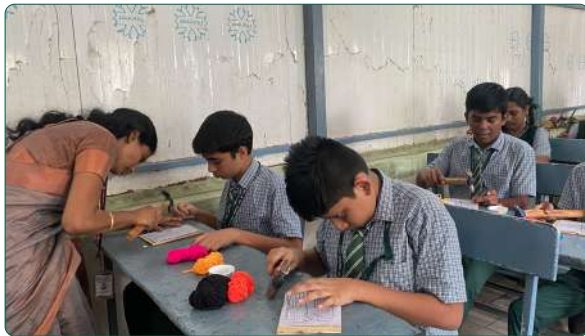

List of Project Summaries

Sparrow Conservation

Under this project so far, we have distributed 10,000 nest boxes and in which 60 % of boxes are occupied by sparrows. This has led to 10 - 15 % increase in sparrow population in North Chennai region alone. Apart from North Chennai we have expanded our work in Velacherry and have found significant growth in sparrow population in that area. We also have found through public that sparrows are found in Villivakkam, Perambur, Kolathur, Tambaram and Pattinambakkam. In near future we are planning to expand our work to these areas also. Thereby in another 10 years we can make sparrow a common sight in entire Chennai city.



Awareness program organized in 35+ school, inaugurated Sparrow Sanctuaries in 10 schools and in 2 gated communities, Organized 30 workshops in different schools and wildlife photography exhibition in 15 different schools. More than 10000 students from various schools and their family members gained basic knowledge of other living things which is helpful for survival of human beings. Not only students, we have reached college students and general public.



String Art – Skill development Program

Skill development training for women aims to empower them with the knowledge and abilities needed to succeed in various aspects of life. These programs provide women with opportunities to learn practical skills such as String Art, financial management, entrepreneurship, communication, leadership to their interests and needs.



It's mainly focusing to generate the revenue for the women of our state who are living like a slave. The people in refugee camp have so many restrictions to access even their basic needs. Due to the restrictions framed by our both state govt and central govt people are struggling lot to lead a peaceful life. By enhancing women's skills in camp, these initiatives enable them to start own businesses, contribute to household income, and ultimately improve their economic independence and overall well-being. Moreover, skill development training for women promotes gender equality and creates a more inclusive and empowered society.

Another Problem is without proper permission from govt authorities, they can't bring the product into the market which is fabricated by the women in the camp. Once the product is ready, we can collect and bring it into market like schools, colleges, some publics stall and also, we can connect with the interior designers too to reach out the product in our society.
